Attendees may use CVA chemistry and equipment, but must bring their own film and photo paper. Please call if interested, studio will not be open if there is no interest.

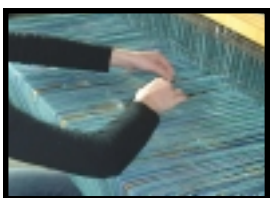

POTTERY

Each pottery class is open to all skill levels. Beginners are introduced to basic wheel throwing techniques and concentrate on clay preparation, centering, throwing basic forms, finishing techniques and the principles of glazing and firing.

Required Materials: sponge, old towel, water container, basic potter's tool kit. More details on the first day of class.
